Jamaica Accountability Meter Portal (JAMP), welcomes the public interest in the information on its website, in particular the accountability scores for Members of Parliament (MP) which is based on available performance information from government and Parliamentary sources.

JAMP is cognizant of the fact that there is increased interest in the integrity and character of political representatives who are expected to be candidates in the general elections set for September 3, 2020, and is especially mindful of the potential impact of the information it posts publicly.

JAMP does significant updating of its information based on the most current data and is now in the process of incorporating the data for the **2019/20 Financial Year**. Information for all MPs is being updated to accurately reflect their standing.

During this process, JAMP ought to have removed the page from public view while they were being updated.

JAMP unreservedly apologizes to those MPs adversely impacted by the availability of incomplete information on their accountability standing - **The Most Hon. Juliet Holness, Hon. Floyd Green, Phillip Paulwell, Horace Dalley, Dr. Ian Hayles, Juliet Cuthbert-Flynn and Luther Buchanan.**

JAMP will have the up-to-date, final assessments, based on 2019/20 information completed and available to the public by Monday August 17, 2020.
